**CarlinVision Surgery Center (CSC)** has been specially designed, equipped and staffed to provide the most advanced eye surgery in surroundings that will make your experience as easy and pleasant as possible.

## Before your procedure:

- If medical clearance is required you may be asked to consult with your primary physician.
- Discontinue blood thinners such as Coumadin, Plavix and aspirin 5 days prior to your procedure, but only if it is approved by the prescribing physician.
- If instructed, start pre-operative eye drops 3 days before your procedure.
- You will be called and advised when to arrive at the center.

## Day of your procedure:

- Do not eat or drink anything after midnight on the night before surgery.
   Do take your routine medicines in the morning with a sip of water EXCEPT do not take blood thinners, diabetic medications and diuretics (water pills).
- Report at your scheduled time so we may administer pre-operative eye drops.
   Our anesthesiologist will talk with you to obtain further medical history, explain his role in your procedure and administer any necessary pre-operative anesthetics.
- Wear a loose neck or a button down shirt/blouse as you will not need to change into a hospital gown. Please do not wear any face or eye make up.
- Bring your driver's license and insurance cards with you. Please leave jewelry and other valuables at home.
- Family members are always welcome. They may wait with you in the pre-op area. At time of surgery they will be directed to a comfortable lounge area where refreshments will be served. A nurse will be able to meet with them there when your procedure is over.
